Becoming a Student-Athlete

- Every student wishing to compete for Oasis High School MUST submit a valid FHSAA Physical (EL2) and Waiver (EL3) on file with the Athletic Department before starting ANY activity. These documents are valid for 365 days from completion and are not finalized without a parent/guardian and student signature on all pages.
 - Florida Department of Health forms cannot be accepted.
- The student **MUST** be covered under their family's health insurance plan. If a family does not have health insurance for their student, they can purchase insurance from <u>Healthy Kids</u>, a Florida KidCare partner.
- Students and their parents can find copies of the required FHSAA forms at <u>http://oasishighschool.net/fhsaa</u>.
- Students with as little as one signature missing will be held from any and all activities until the issue has been resolved.
