

Oasis Charter High School Prom Dress and Behavioral Code

The administration and staff at Oasis High School expect our students to make good choices. Prom will be a fun and memorable evening for everyone. Please be reminded that the Code Of Conduct applies.

General Info:

- All fees and fines must be cleared prior to ticket purchase.
- Prom will be held at the Sanibel Harbour Marriott Resort;
17260 Harbour Pointe Drive, Ft. Myers, FL 33908. DO NOT CROSS THE SANIBEL BRIDGE. It's the last right before the bridge.
- Students are to utilize the parking garage for complimentary self-parking or valet parking.
- The dance is through the hotel lobby and up the left staircase. There is no room provided to store personal items.
- Check-in will start at 6:00pm. Dinner begins promptly at 6:15pm with the dance starting immediately afterwards.
- Upon check-in ALL students need a valid ticket and a picture ID.
- If you bring a Non-Oasis guest, they must arrive and depart with you. (Permission slips are required for NON-STUDENT guests, and must be turned in at the time of ticket purchase.)

Dress Code:

A dress code check and search area will be set up for students and guests to pass through prior to entering the dance. Any student or guest inappropriately dressed will be denied entry to the event.

Ladies:

- Generally wear semi-formal/formal attire. Strapless and spaghetti straps are permitted.
- Dresses must be longer than mid-thigh (front and back), including slits in attire.
- Dresses may be backless; however the cut must be at or above the natural waist.
- The front cut of the dress must provide sufficient coverage.
- Heels can be worn.

Gentlemen:

- Generally wear semi-formal wear, such as slacks, dress shoes, and a dress shirt. Ties are encouraged.
- Gentlemen's shirts must remain buttoned throughout the event.
- Jeans and clothing with tears are considered inappropriate attire for this event and are prohibited.

Behavioral Code:

- All students must make good decisions, be safe, have fun, and inform their invited guest of the dress code and expectations for the dance.
- Appropriate dancing is expected at all Oasis High Dances and will be monitored by administration/chaperones. Any dancing which may result in disruption or injury is prohibited. Inappropriate dancing will result in removal from the event. If a staff member determines a student is exhibiting inappropriate dancing/gestures, a warning will be provided. If the student continues to dance/behave inappropriately the student will be removed from the dance. If a student is removed, a staff member will notify the parent/guardian regarding arrangements for transportation.
- Students will remain inside designated areas of the dance facility at all times.
- All students attending an Oasis High event are aware of the possibility of random alcohol testing or the search of property if any bags or oversized purses are brought in.

Consequences:

This dance is a school-sponsored activity and therefore all aspects of the Student Code of Conduct apply to both students and pre-approved guests.

Note to Parents/Guardians:

Dance hours are 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Students are expected to make arrangements for appropriate drop off and pick-up times. Re-entry is prohibited. Anyone who arrives at the dance after 7:15pm will not be permitted entrance.

IMPORTANT:

A school dance is defined as an extracurricular activity. As such, “all students participating in extracurricular activities...must comply with the conduct required by the *Code of Conduct for Students*.” To provide a safe and orderly environment for this event, a search may be conducted of all students and their guests prior to admittance. Any item prohibited in the *Code of Conduct for Students* is also prohibited at all extracurricular activities and will be confiscated and dealt with in alignment with the discipline policy. For quickest entrance into the event, please have your ID and ticket easily accessible. It is also recommended to refrain from bringing bags/purses. Small purses are permitted and are the responsibility of the owner at all times. Oasis High is not responsible for loss or theft during the event.
