- Coach Haba (Baseball) Frank Haba, originally from New York, has been at the helm of the Oasis High School Baseball program since 2010. After playing baseball for Coach Frank Miele at Mahopac High School, he played collegiately for four years at Pace University (Pleasantville NY). Coach Haba has coached the great sport of baseball at various levels, but started his coaching career at perennial New York State baseball powerhouse Roy C. Ketcham High School where he was fortunate enough to learn under the tutelage of Coach Pat Mealy, who has won several "Coach of the Year" awards, including New York State High School Coach of the Year. Coach Haba is dedicated and committed year after year to making the players in the OHS Sharks Baseball program not only better baseball players, but even better young men.
- Coach Flood (Tennis) Mike Flood has been coaching tennis at the high school and collegiate levels for over 15 years. His teams have been consistently competitive in both singles and doubles. #### **Becoming a Student-Athlete**

• Every student wishing to compete for Oasis High School **MUST** have a valid FHSAA Physical (EL2) and Waiver (EL3) on file with the Athletic Department before starting **ANY** activity. These documents are valid for 365 days from completion and are not finalized without a parent/guardian and student signature on all pages.

#### • Florida Department of Health forms cannot be accepted.

- The student MUST be covered under their family's health insurance plan. If a family does not have health insurance for their student, they can purchase insurance from <u>Healthy Kids</u>, a Florida KidCare partner.
- Students and their parents can find copies of the required FHSAA forms at <u>http://oasishighschool.net/fhsaa</u>.
- Students with as little as one signature missing will be held from any and all activities until the issue has been resolved.

## **Our Next Issue**

- Details for the 2017 summer camp schedule will be released by Spring Break. In year's past we have offered volleyball and basketball camps that are available to students from all four Charter Schools and beyond our walls.
