

Cambridge International School

The Cambridge program at Oasis is rigorous and engaging, comparable to both Advanced Placement (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB) programs. Students participating in coursework are ultimately preparing to take the end of course AICE exams. Successful passing scores result in earned college credits with the possibility to earn up to 45 credits. Students have the flexibility to choose classes based on their individual interest/skillset. While working through the program, students also can earn their Advanced International Certificate of Education Diploma. The AICE International Diploma is earned by passing at least 7 exams, combined with community service hours can earn the highest tier of the Bright Future's Scholarship which is recognized by all Florida state college and universities.

Florida Southwestern College Dual Enrollment

Students can be dual enrolled at both Oasis High and Florida Southwestern College. Students can take college courses online or in person. Dual Enrollment is free but requires an approved application.



FSW Dual Enrollment School of Business and Technology Tracks:

Upon completion, Oasis students can potentially enter the job market as an entry level programmer or web designer.
