



Semi-Annual Asbestos Inspection Form

By the end of June and December each year, visually inspect all areas identified in the management plan as Asbestos Contained Building Material (ACBM) or assumed ACBM.

Form Instructions:

This electronic form must be submitted twice each year, after the inspection has taken place.

1. When completing this form, please be sure to FIRST save a copy to your computer hard drive.
2. Once you have completed the form, save the form again.
3. Print a hard copy by clicking on "Print File Copy". The Individual Inspecting and the Principal must sign this copy.
4. Make a photocopy for your Asbestos Management Plan Folder in your safety drawer.
5. Send the signed original via the pony to Fire, Safety, and Inspections, Attn: Robbyn Hall
6. Submit the completed form electronically to Robbyn Hall by clicking on "Submit Electronic Version".
7. Check whether or not the form was successfully submitted by looking in your Outlook sent mailbox.

All district sites:

In 1986 Congress created AHERA (The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act). This act requires all school districts to put the below information out to parents, students, and visitors. Most our school sites have letters from the architect noting no asbestos building material was used, however, there may be some roofing material or fire rated doors with insulation inside of them that could contain the fire-retardant material. We ask all sites to please disclose the clause below in one of your school newsletters, small and direct, and forward to Safety and Security so we can mark compliance.

In 1986 Congress created AHERA (The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act). This act requires all school districts to put the below information out to parents, students, and possible visitors. All district sites have a current AHERA (The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act) Inspection and most have a letter of exemption on file from the architect. Certain asbestos-containing materials or assumed asbestos-containing materials such as: fire doors, roofing materials, or other building materials could still contain ACBM and are monitored for no damage. In the School District of Lee County there is an active management plan for each district site. The report listing the location, quantities, and condition of any or all known materials, is available at the school's front office for inspection during normal school hours. Copies of the school's asbestos file can be supplied to you at a cost.
