

## GATHERING THE DOCUMENTS NEEDED FOR FAFSA

## To complete the 2021-2022 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), you will need:

- Student and Parent FSA ID to sign electronically.
- Student Social Security Number
- Student Alien Registration number (if student is not a U.S. citizen)
- Parent(s) Social Security Number (if applicable)
  - Note: If your parent doesn't have an SSN, enter all zeros (e.g., 000000000).
     Don't enter an Individual Taxpayer Identification Number in the "Social Security number" field.
- Student and Parent(s) Date of Birth
- Know your parents date of marriage or divorce
- Student driver's license number if you have one
- Parent(s) and student (*if applicable*) **2019** federal income tax returns, W-2s, and other records of money earned.
  - IRS Data Retrieval Tool- allows students and parents who filed a U.S tax return with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) to access the IRS tax return information and transfer data directly into FAFSA form. We recommend having access to the physical returns so that you enter the information exactly as it appears into the IRS Data Retrieval Tool.
- Information of untaxed income (child support received or paid, interest income, veteran's non-education benefits, etc.)
- Information on food stamps (SNAP) benefits received during the last two calendar years (if any)
- Household size
- Information on cash, savings and checking account balances in your bank account
- Information on investments, including stocks and bonds and real estate, not including
  the home in which you live; and business and farm assets for you, and for your parents if
  you are a dependent student
